Cinnamomum zeylanicum

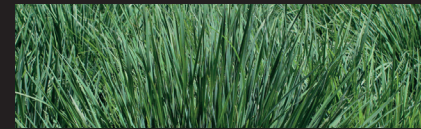

Syzygium aromaticum

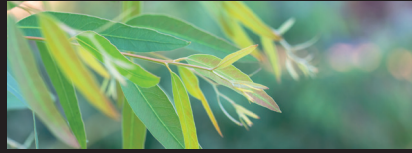

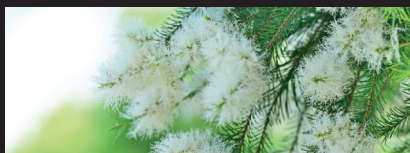

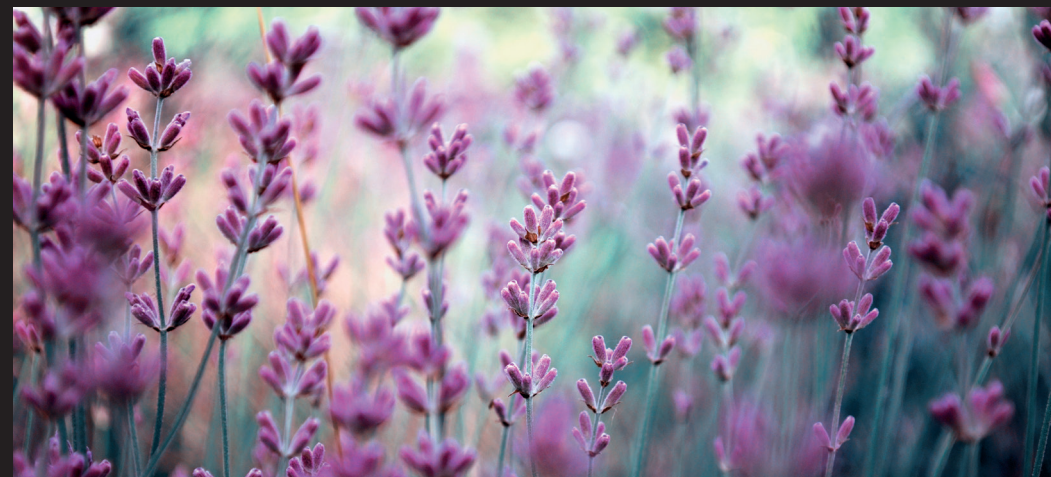
